

WHAT IS MANAGED HOME NURSING?

Managed home nursing is a process where teamwork insures that clients receive quality, effective and affordable care and nursing within the comfort of their home tailored to their personal needs.

- Services can be adjusted at any time according to the personal circumstances and needs of the patient
